
Saved Criteria in Search


How to use Saved Criteria:

Visit My Account to save your recurring selections, then use them to populate filter criteria in future Search orders. Follow these guick and intuitive steps to get started.


- Log in to cbsearch.collegeboard.org and select your organization's department name under the drop-down menu ("Sample College Undergraduate ADMISSIONS")
- Click on "Names Remaining" (or "Account Type: Per-Name")
- 3. Click on "Your Saved Criteria"
- 4. Under Add Criteria Type, select the filter group you'd like to configure


5. Name your criteria group, enter your selections, and click "Save and Close" to create



6. View "Your Saved Criteria" list to add Criterion Types or Edit/Delete your previous selections

7. Now you can utilize your saved criteria in your Search orders—click "Start a New Search" or open a saved order to find your criteria within the corresponding filter drop-down



8. Click "Apply" to confirm your selection and proceed with your order. You can also inform other users within your Search department of your saved preferences as any user can use the same saved criteria.



Saved Criteria While Building an Order:

You can create a Saved Criteria grouping while building an order by selecting "Save to Search Preferences" when selecting criteria under Geography, College Board Exams, and Intended Majors.



Saved Criteria Use Cases from Peer Institutions:

- Zip code or geomarket lists for primary, secondary, and tertiary markets
- Major groupings for specific program outreach initiatives
- AP Exam courses with credit-bearing score ranges
- Segment Analysis Service (SAS) cluster groupings for attributes such as propensity to apply, out-of-state mobility, access initiatives, and more!
